LMC Student Dress Code for Job Shadowing or Internships



LMC Student Dress Code

Objective

Students will be easily identifiable to staff and customers.

- 1. Students are required to wear proper attire to job shadow.
- 2. Students not following the dress code will not be allowed to job shadow or intern.

DRESS CODE

Shirt

- Long or short sleeved collared plain polo/oxford shirts required in white, navy blue or light blue from any vendor
 is acceptable. All shirts must have collars and sleeves.
- Designs, contrasting stitching, embroidery, emblems, insignias, monograms and logos are not allowed.
- Solid undershirts may be worn under polo/oxford shirts with only the neck line showing. Undershirts must be in the same unified dress code colors - white, navy blue or light blue. No design from undershirts may show through polo/oxford shirts.
- Students are encouraged to tuck in shirts.

Pants

- Plain solid color khaki or navy blue chino, twill or corduroy pants from any vendor are acceptable.
- No Sagging and baggy pants are not allowed. No undergarment waistbands can be exposed.
- Designs, contrasting stitching, embroidery, emblems, insignias, monograms and logos are not allowed.

Shoes

- Closed toed shoes are required. (tennis / running / court shoes)
- Sock/hose are required.
- If shoes have laces, they must be laced up and tied.
- No flip-flops or beach sandals.

Jewelry

- Jewelry should be tastefully minimized and appropriate for all business and professional attire.
- Earrings are acceptable for female only, if they are conservative (maximum of two earrings per ear).
- Other visible body piercing is not allowed.
- Excessive jewelry should not be worn. Long necklaces, bracelets, long earrings, etc. are not acceptable as they present a safety hazard.

Personal Hygiene

- Perfume/cologne is not allowed because of patient sensitivity.
- Artificial nails, extenders, acrylic, silk wraps, overlays and/or tips are not permitted for direct patient care experiences.
- Long hair should be pulled back.
- Exposure of tattoos are discouraged. If any person should consider the existing tattoo offensive, it must be covered.

Badge

 Due to Public Safety and Security precautions, each student must display their School Identification Badge at all times while on the LMC campus.
