COMMISSIONED ART ~ \$30,000

As you enter the new outpatient Infusion Center at Lexington Medical Center, the lobby will be enhanced with an artistic focal point created by a local artist. This piece will help create a calming environment for patients during this difficult time.

RESOURCE ROOM ~ \$25,000

New Infusion Center

With more than 1,000 new cancer diagnoses each year, the increased demand for outpatient infusion services at Lexington Medical Center has led to a new Infusion Center at Lexington Oncology Associates that is scheduled to open in the spring of 2012. The state-of-the-art facility will feature cutting-edge technologies as well as "comfort" items provided by generous Foundation donors.

Supporting Patient Needs

As the number of cancer patients continues to grow and medications become more costly, the Foundation will need to increase our support of emergency needs and prescription assistance for cancer patients.
