#### **Ann Wingate Scholarship (\$1000.00)**

- Letter of acceptance into nursing (Pre Nursing Program meets requirement)
- Student has been accepted into an Associate Degree Program in Nursing
- High school transcript with GPA, class rank, and SAT or ACT scores
- Two letters of Recommendation (not a relative)
- Essay of approximately 200 words stating why I chose nursing as a profession
- Application must be complete

#### **Medhurst/Norton/Telfer Scholarship (\$2000.00)**

- Letter of acceptance to a college or university
- Student has been accepted into a Nursing Baccalaureate Degree Program
- For freshmen, acceptance into a Pre Nursing Program meets requirement
- High School Transcript with GPA, class rank, and SAT or ACT scores
- Two letters of Recommendation (not a relative)
- Essay of approximately 200 words stating why I chose nursing as a profession
- Application must be complete

#### **Sandra Dodd Continuing Education Students (\$1000.00)**

- Prior scholarship recipients are encouraged to apply
- Student has been accepted into a Nursing Baccalaureate Degree Program
- College student with a sophomore or higher standing, who has gained or will gain, full acceptance into a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing Program
- Letter of endorsement from the Dean or other Official of the Nursing Program is required
- One additional letter of recommendation (not a relative)
- College transcript with GPA
- Essay of approximately 200 words stating what nursing means to me
- Application must be complete

#### **Cook/Price Mature Student Scholarships (\$1000.00)**

Awarded to mature nursing students in a two-year (2) or four-year (4) program

- Acceptance to an Associate or Baccalaureate or Pre Nursing Program
- A letter of acceptance is required
- Two letters of recommendation (not a relative)
- Transcript of prior academic work with GPA, if available
- Essay of approximately 200 words stating what nursing means to me
- Application must be complete

#### **Auxiliary Volunteer Memorial Scholarship (\$3000.00)**

- One scholarship will be awarded each year. No separate applications needed. The Scholarship Committee will select a student showing superior academic ability from the applications received.

The completed application with all required attachments, letters, etc. must be received in the Volunteer Office of Lexington Medical Center by **March 14, 2022 at 4:00 pm.**

**WHO SHOULD APPLY**

**Ann Wingate Scholarship** - Lexington County School seniors or students living in Lexington County with a GED certificate from a high school program. Students must be accepted into a Nursing Associate Program (two year degree).

**Medhurst/Norton/Telfer Scholarship** - Lexington County School seniors or students living in Lexington County with a GED certificate from a high school program. Students must be accepted into a Baccalaureate Degree Program (four year degree).

**Sandra Dodd Continuing Education Scholarship** - Lexington County residents in college continuing to work toward a (four year degree) in nursing. Preference given to prior scholarship winners.

**Cook/Price Mature Student Scholarship** - Lexington County residents who are no longer in high school and would like to earn a degree in nursing. Preference given to employees of Lexington Medical Center.
