



PATIENT CARE

The Foundation supports Lexington Medical Center's mission by enhancing hospital services and providing hope through patient and community programs. These services and programs affect every area of patient care in Lexington Medical Center's Network of Care.

AED CABINET SUPPLIES

Provides automated external defibrillator cabinets and supplies throughout Lexington Medical Center's main campus to ensure appropriate responses to crisis events

BABY DOLL THERAPY

Uses baby dolls and stuffed animals to comfort patients who may suffer from varying stages of dementia or Alzheimer's disease

BARIATRIC SURGERY TOOLKIT

Provides the necessary tools to be successful after receiving bariatric surgery

BLOOD SUGAR TESTING SUPPLIES

Provides educational and motivational materials to newly diagnosed or uncontrolled diabetic patients to help them become more comfortable with monitoring their blood sugar at home

CLINICAL EDUCATION WITH CHESTER CHEST™

Provides a central venous training simulator for accessing, deaccessing and dressing changes for ports in the Emergency department and Oncology unit

CLOTHING FOR EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT PATIENTS

Provides clothing for patients who do not have appropriate attire for discharge

COGNITIVE CART

Provides patients with small tokens and items that promote attention and concentration to decrease delirium

COMMUNITY OUTREACH, PROJECT PRESCRIPTION AND PROJECT TRANSPORTATION

Provides assistance with medication and transportation for patients who are uninsured or underinsured within the Lexington Medical Center network

COMPLEX CARE PATIENT SUPPLIES

Provides care items to patients who have been admitted to the hospital for an extended stay

D2 & ME DIABETES SUPPORT GROUP

Provides support and wellness advice for type 2 diabetes patients and their caregivers

DIABETES EDUCATION

Disperses educational and motivational materials focused on diabetes to underserved rural populations, such as Batesburg–Leesville and Swansea

DIABETIC SUPPLIES

Provides supplies to newly diagnosed diabetes patients at Lexington Medical Center's main hospital, as well as at physician practices in Batesburg–Leesville and Swansea

EAT WELL PROGRAM

Provides cooking skills to people with diabetes hypertension and heart disease

EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT HOSPITALITY CART

Provides essentials for patients during emergency visits

ELECTRIC WHEELCHAIR RESTORATION (LEXINGTON MEDICAL CENTER EXTENDED CARE)

Provides electric wheelchairs to aid the mobility of residents

EXERCISE IS MEDICINE PROGRAM

Provides specialized training for individuals with cancer, chronic disease and diabetes, among other conditions

EXTENDED CARE HOSPITALITY CART (LEXINGTON MEDICAL CENTER EXTENDED CARE)

Offers small items for residents to assist with daily activities

EYEGLOSS CASES

Provides padded eyeglass cases for surgical patients

FALL PREVENTION AND SAFE PATIENT MOBILITY

Provides tools to help direct patient care staff with ambulating patients who need assistance

HEALTHSTREAM® MYCLINICALEXCHANGE PLATFORM

Schedules and onboards nursing students electronically

HEART BEARS

Provides a teddy bear to family members that includes the patient's heartbeat recorded by Doppler

HOSPITAL TO HOME

Provides non-medical in-home care to high-risk patients who have been discharged from the hospital

INFANT MANNEQUIN CPR COMMUNITY CLASSES

For use at Safe Sitter® babysitting classes and community-based classes where participants learn how to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation

INTERACTIVE ENGAGEMENT SYSTEM (LEXINGTON MEDICAL CENTER EXTENDED CARE)

Provides an interactive computer system for residents, including rehabilitation therapy for individuals or groups

LYMPHATECH EXPANDED LYMPHEDEMA PROGRAM

Provides tools to assist outpatient rehabilitation staff with pre-and post-evaluation care

LYMPHEDEMA SUPPLY FUND

Provides uninsured and underinsured lymphedema patients with compression wraps

MEDICAL INTENSIVE CARE UNIT KEEPSAKE HANDS

Provides 3D hand-casting kits for families who experience unexpected loss in the Medical Intensive Care Unit

SIMULATION LAB PEDIATRIC MANNEQUINS

Pediatric mannequins that improve the simulation lab capabilities.

STOP THE BLEED

Classes for all LMC staff and volunteers, as well as the community, with training that comes with a tourniquet for attendees to keep.

TOTAL JOINT PROGRAM TOTE BAG

Patients that attend the Total Joint Replacement class prior to surgery receive a tote bag to carry the necessary items needed for after surgery.
