Video Visit Instructions

Thank you for choosing Lexington Medical Center to meet your health care needs. Your provider may now be using video visits as a convenient alternative to office visits. Your video visit may take place using Zoom, FaceTime or Google Duo:

Using Zoom:



- Search for Zoom in your App Store and download.
- Once installed, click to open.



• Before your visit begins, you will receive an email from your provider. Click the link in the email below "Join Zoom Meeting."

Using FaceTime:



• Your provider will call your mobile number at the time of your visit.



• FaceTime is installed on all Apple devices, so you do not need to download any software.

Using Google Duo:



- Search for Google Duo in your App Store and download.
- Once installed, click to open.
- Click Give access to allow Google Duo access to your camera and microphone for video calling.

General Tips:

- **Complete a test run**. If interactive technology like Zoom or FaceTime is new to you, try it with a family member or friend prior to your first visit. If using Zoom, be sure to enable your video.
- Find a private, quiet space before your video visit. Limit background noise such as TVs or side conversations. Check your lighting and sound.
- Look at your device screen to make sure you are in front of the camera and see yourself on screen.
- Unmute your device. Avoid wearing accessories that create sound interference.
- Dress appropriately. When your provider connects to your video visit, he or she will see you and anything in the background.
